GENERAL APPLICATION OF CHARGES

40 ITEM 600

ALT CHARGES FOR USE, NON-USE AND DETENTION OF HEAVY CAPACITY OR SPECIAL TYPE FLAT CARS

(All charges herein are stated and payable in United States currency)

1. Charges assessed under this item will accrue to Airlake Terminal Railway Co. and are assigned and payable to Progressive Rail Specialized Logistics, agent for Airlake Terminal Railway Co., P. O. Box 578, Lakeville, MN 55044. The use or additional detention charges will apply on ALT cars when these cars are furnished for use in:
 - A. Line haul service for all carriers.
 - B. Switching service for all carriers.
2. By using ALT heavy-capacity cars covered by this tariff, Customer agrees to the following:
 - A. Customer agrees that all charges are due within 15 days of invoice date. All invoices are subject to a 1.5% per month finance charge if unpaid within 30 days from the date of invoice. Customer agrees to pay all collection costs, including attorney fees, if required to collect in this manner.
 - B. Customer agrees that all charges owed by the customer including use fees, detention, dunnage removal, or repairs to the railcar are payable by the party ordering the car and in no case will charges be divided among parties.
 - C. Customer agrees to assume responsibility to remove all dunnage from the cars in such a manner as to cause no damage to the cars before the cars are released empty to serving railroad. Customer further agrees to pay Airlake Terminal Railway Co. within credit terms referenced in this tariff for any invoiced charges associated with dunnage removal or car repair due to improper loading or unloading.
 - D. Customer agrees to consult the current copy of The Official Railway Equipment Register for proper lading weight distribution and any other restrictions.
 - E. Customer agrees to recognize Progressive Rail Specialized Logistics as the authorized agent for Airlake Terminal Railway Co.
3. Charges assessed under this item will be in addition to any other charges, including normal demurrage charges, and will be billed and collected by ALT.
4. These charges will apply at or between all stations in the United States, and/or Canada and/or Mexico.
5. ALT cars and their basis for charges. If a ALT car is not listed in this item, but is listed in the Heavy Duty and Special Flat Car Section of Tariff RER 6414 Series, the use charge will be that provided under basis for charges "1", also the additional detention charges or non-use charge will apply to the unlisted car.

ALT CHARGES FOR USE, NON-USE AND DETENTION OF HEAVY CAPACITY OR SPECIAL TYPE FLAT CARS

ADDITIONAL DETENTION CHARGES (Cont'd)

B. Placement is defined as follows:

1. ACTUAL - When a car is placed in an accessible position for loading or unloading, or at a point designated by the consignor or consignee.
2. CONSTRUCTIVE - When a car cannot be actually placed because of any condition attributable to the consignor or consignee and the car is held on railroad tracks.

NON-USE CHARGE

- A. When an ALT car has been ordered and shipper is notified by carrier representative of car number assigned, and car is enroute empty to assignee, and the car order is subsequently cancelled or postponed, shipper ordering car will be assessed a charge of \$750.00 per car. This charge will not apply if carrier is unable to place car on date ordered for placement.

41 ITEM 688-C

NS CHARGES FOR USE, NON-USE AND DETENTION OF HEAVY CAPACITY OR SPECIAL TYPE FLAT CARS

1. The use or additional detention charges will apply on cars of NS ownership when these cars are furnished for use in:
 - A. Line-haul service for all carriers.
 - B. Switching service for all carriers.
 - C. Charges for switching service by NS are published in Tariff NS 8001 Series.
2. The NON-USE charge will apply on cars of all ownership, except it will not apply to cars of TTX ownership.
3. Charges assessed under this item will accrue to NS. Origin detention charges will be paid to NS by the origin line-haul carrier. Destination detention charges will be paid to NS by the destination line-haul carrier.
4. Charges assessed under this item will be in addition to any other charges, including normal demurrage charges.
5. These charges will apply at or between all stations in the United States and/or Canada.
6. Cars of NS ownership and their basis for charges. If a car of NS ownership is NOT listed in this item, but is listed in the HEAVY DUTY AND SPECIAL FLAT CAR section of Tariff RER 6413, the use charge will be that provided under basis for charges "4": also the additional detention charges or non-use charge will apply to the unlisted car.

A. Application of BASIS FOR CHARGES (Dollars Per Car):

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ADDITIONAL DETENTION CHARGES

A. When cars of NS ownership (except for those cars with "Basis for Charges" equal to "1") are held, the following detention charges (in Dollars Per Car) will be assessed for each 24-hour period, or fraction thereof, after the First 0001-hour after placement, or after notification if the car is held enroute:

1st 24 hours _____	FREE
2nd 24 hours _____	FREE
3rd 24 hours _____	250
4th 24 hours _____	325
5th 24 hours _____	400
6th 24 hours _____	500
7th 24 hours _____	500
8th 24 hours _____	500
9th 24 hours and each subsequent 24 hours _____	1,000

B. When a car, other than NS ownership, is held in NS's account, a charge of \$55.00 dollars per car will be assessed for each 24-hour period, or fraction thereof, after the First 0001-hour after placement or after notification if the car is held enroute.

EXCEPTION - Detention charge will not apply to cars of TTX Company ownership, or on NS cars with basis for charges "1". For charges to apply on cars of TTX Company ownership, see Item 690 Series.

C. Placement is defined as follows:

ACTUAL - When a car is placed in an accessible position for loading or unloading, or at a point designated by the consignee or consignor.

CONSTRUCTIVE - When a car cannot be actually placed because of any condition attributable to the consignor or consignee and the car is held on railroad tracks.

NON-USE CHARGE

A. When an NS car has been ordered and shipper is notified by carrier representative of car number assignee, and car is enroute empty to assignee, and the car order is subsequently cancelled or postponed, shipper ordering car will be assessed a charge of \$500.00 per car. This charge will not apply if carrier is unable to place car on date ordered for placement.

NON-USE CHARGE

B. NS may, at its discretion, secure a special type flat car owned or leased by another carrier (foreign line). If a shipper cancels or postpones an order for such foreign line car after the car is billed and forwarded, whether on NS or not, shipper ordering car will be assessed a charge of \$500.00 per car. This charge will not apply if carrier is unable to place car on date ordered for placement, provided that a reasonable period of time is allowed to furnish a car. If a shipper orders a car for "as soon as possible" delivery and then cancels the order the charge will still apply if the car has been billed and forwarded.

ESCALATION OF CHARGES

A. Charges named in this item are NOT subject to RCCR, selective or any other form of tariff increase provisions.
